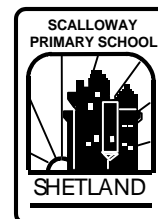




Scalloway Primary School Newsletter March 2019

School Roll and Classes for 2018/19 - Further information on classes and teachers for next session will be shared with you next term.

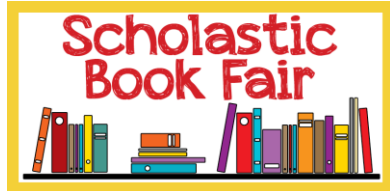
